

# **2023 LOCAL LEAD RECRUITMENT** INFO GUIDE

WHAT IS THE NASA INTERNATIONAL SPACE APPS CHALLENGE? On October 7-8, 2023 NASA is inviting coders, entrepreneurs, scientists, designers, storytellers, makers, builders, artists, and technologists to participate in our 12th annual hackathon - <u>The NASA International Space Apps</u> <u>Challenge.</u> During a 2 day hackathon, participants from around the world will create teams and projects with access to free and open space agency data and expertise. Last year, Space Apps had 31,500+ registered participants from 162 countries and territories, tackling 22 challenges.

**WHAT IS A LOCAL LEAD?** Local Leads organize the event for a specific city or town, working to increase awareness and engagement of the Space Apps Challenge taking place October 7-8, 2023. <u>The deadline to apply to be a Local Lead is June 15th, 2023.</u>

## LOCAL LEAD BENEFITS

- Serve as a Local Lead alongside NASA and the Space Apps Global Organizing Team to develop the world's largest annual global hackathon, with participants and supporting teammates in 160+ countries
- Champion Space Apps in your local community, recruiting local coders, scientists, students, artists, storytellers, designers, engineers, data experts and others who may participate during the Space Apps event(October 7-8, 2023)
- Immerse yourself and serve as a thought leader in your city's space, tech, innovation, and creative communities
- Support noteworthy participants in their hackathon journeys. Nominate top projects for judging at the Global level, with Global Nominees, Global Finalists, and Global Winners being recognized by NASA

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES OF A LOCAL LEAD**

- Local Leads are expected to plan and host a virtual or in person event, recruit, manage and support participants, and coordinate local sponsors, local judges, their team and community members.
- They keep their local event engaging and accessible.
- Often many Local Leads will teach or coordinate workshops to encourage learning new skills or coordinate meet-ups for their participants.
